



Members' Code of Conduct

Being a Yodel Club Heimattreu choir member involves not only singing beautifully but also adhering to certain **etiquette and practices** that contribute to a harmonious and successful choir experience. By following these guidelines, members create a positive and supportive environment that fosters musical excellence, respect, and personal growth for all.

Respect

All members are expected to show respect for each other, the Artistic Choir Director, and any other professionals or volunteers associated with the choir. Maintain professionalism by refraining from making discriminatory or abusive comments and treat others with kindness and consideration.

Attendance

Attend rehearsals, performances, and other choir events consistently, be punctual, and be prepared to participate fully. If you cannot attend a rehearsal or event, please inform a member of the Music Committee at the earliest. Recognize that choir singing is a team effort that requires cooperation.

Vocal and physical warm-ups

Always participate in vocal and physical warm-ups. Warming up your voice improves sound quality and prevents vocal strain. The physical warm-up prepares you for the physical demands of singing.

Do your homework and practice at home.

Learn your parts outside rehearsal by utilizing the provided online distant learning facility. Avoid relying solely on others to support you during rehearsal. Strive to improve your musical skills and knowledge and be open for feedback and seek growth.

Technology

Refrain from using technology in a way that is disruptive to the choir or its members. Utilize the available digital song index and use phones, tablets etc. in a responsible manner during rehearsals, performances, and other choir events.

Attire

Members are expected to always maintain their uniforms in excellent and clean condition. Dress for performances, and other choir events as directed by the Music Committee.

Feedback

Members are expected to give and receive feedback constructively and respectfully, and to use feedback to improve their individual performance and the overall success of the choir.

Pay attention to the director's guidance to achieve blend and balance. Your voice contributes to the collective sound.
